Erie House Set to Host Future of Promise Awards Dinner on March 14

The fundraising gala will garner support for a program aimed at strengthening families, nurturing safer communities and increasing access to mental health resources.

February 1, 2019 (CHICAGO)—Erie Neighborhood House will host its annual Future of Promise Awards Dinner on Thursday, March 14, in the Atlantic Ballroom of downtown Chicago's Radisson Blu Aqua (221 N Columbus Dr).
